Beginning in summer 2026, ICP and Spéos will jointly present a series of photography courses in Paris, bringing together the teaching expertise and creative communities of both institutions. The program will include the **Summer Photography Course – Introduction to Photography** which is an eight-week program that students can join for individual weeks, or for the full program at a discount.

The courses will take place in person at the Spéos campus in Paris and will be taught in English by instructors from both ICP and Spéos. Through a co-teaching model, students will benefit from multiple perspectives and approaches to photographic practice, combining the international educational traditions of both schools.

Participants will have the opportunity to explore photographic techniques and visual storytelling while working in one of the world's most iconic cultural capitals. The program is designed for photographers looking to deepen their practice in an immersive learning environment that blends studio instruction, classroom dialogue, and photographic exploration throughout the city.

This collaboration reflects a shared commitment by ICP and Spéos to support emerging and established photographers through rigorous education, creative exchange, and international engagement.
