ICP's Teen Academy program offers a range of opportunities for teenagers to develop their knowledge of photography, critical thinking, writing, and public speaking.

Courses include 10-week black-and-white and color darkroom instruction, digital intensives, and a yearlong advanced program called Imagemakers. All curricula include: darkroom time, visual presentations, photographic and writing assignments, discussions, critiques, a guest artist visit, and a field trip. By the end of each course, students will have developed a portfolio of prints and an artist statement. All classes culminate in a final presentation for family and friends to celebrate the students' achievements.
