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Teen Academy Imagemakers enables motivated high school juniors and seniors to advance their photography, writing, and public speaking skills while developing an awareness of the creative and professional possibilities in the field. This weekly after-school program provides teen photographers with guidance from some of New York's best teaching artists, field trips to museums, galleries, and studios, college-prep workshops, pre-professional assignments, mentorship opportunities in the field, and extensive access to ICP's facilities. This program is designed for students who are interested in pursuing photography in college and/or as a career. By the end of the year, students will create an extensive portfolio, including an artist's statement and résumé. A selection of their best work is featured in a culminating gallery exhibition.

Scholarships are available for all Teen Academy classes.

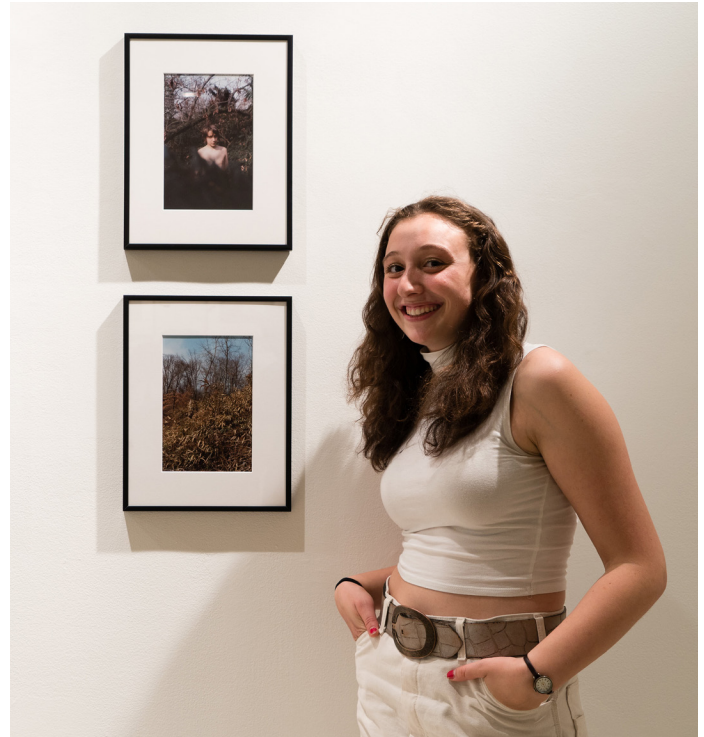
